Visa Information

Please make sure to carefully check the requirements and conditions for your visa. In case of a E-tourist visa upon arrival, your biometric data will be collected at the airport. You will likely also be asked for the purpose of your visit, we recommend stating 'visiting (Montessori) friends' as the purpose of your visit to India.

Arrival times

Based on the arrival times sent in, there will be someone to pick you up at the Hyderabad Rajiv Gandhi International airport. After collecting your luggage, look for someone with a sign with your name written on it. The costs for transportation are included in the participation fee, we will settle the costs for transportation directly, you do not need to pay.

Please note that the nights from 30/07 to 13/08 are included in the Assembly participation fee. Extra nights will be billed separately and all additional costs (e.g. laundry, room service, etc.) straight to the hotel. Participants that are arriving early might sometimes be accommodated in a different room first, depending on availability.
